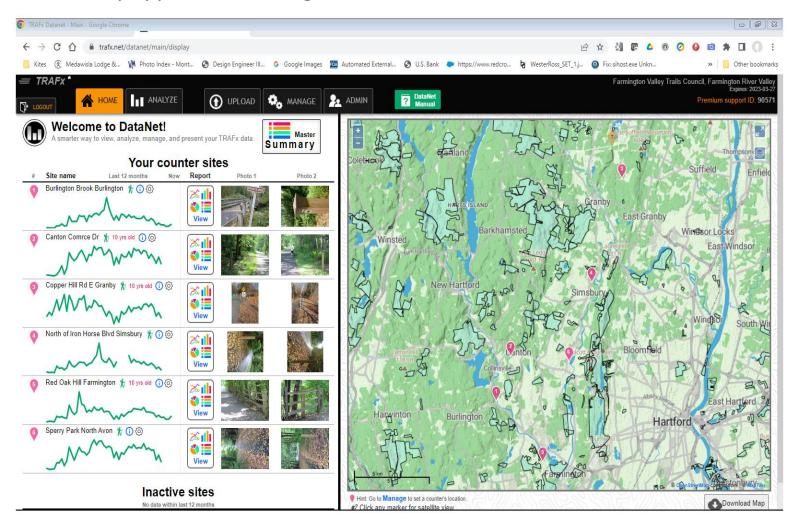

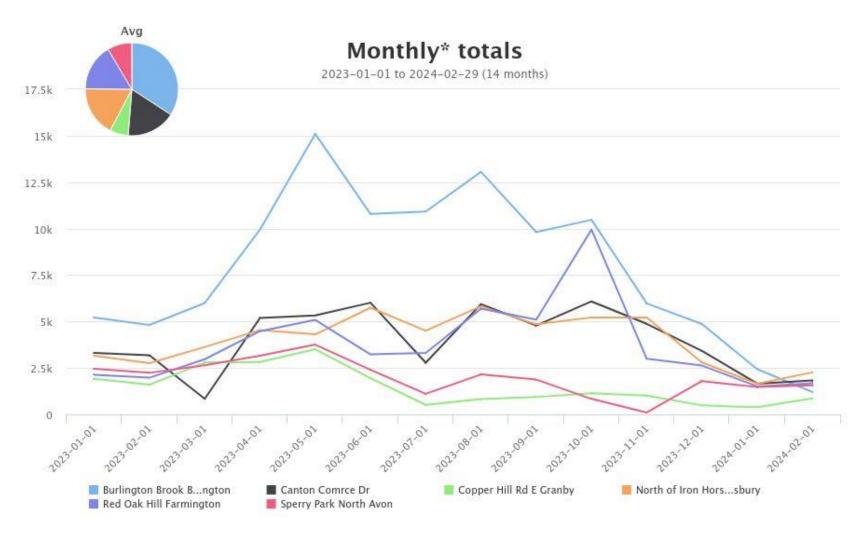

Counters The counters are simple infrared detectors.

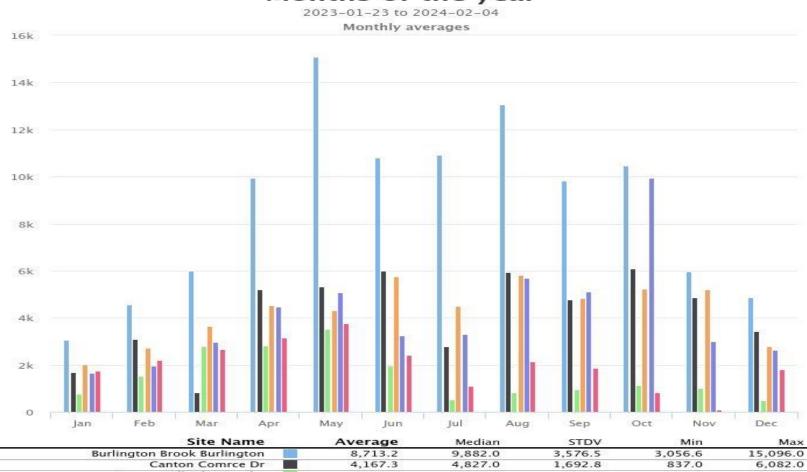


Graph of total usage 2023

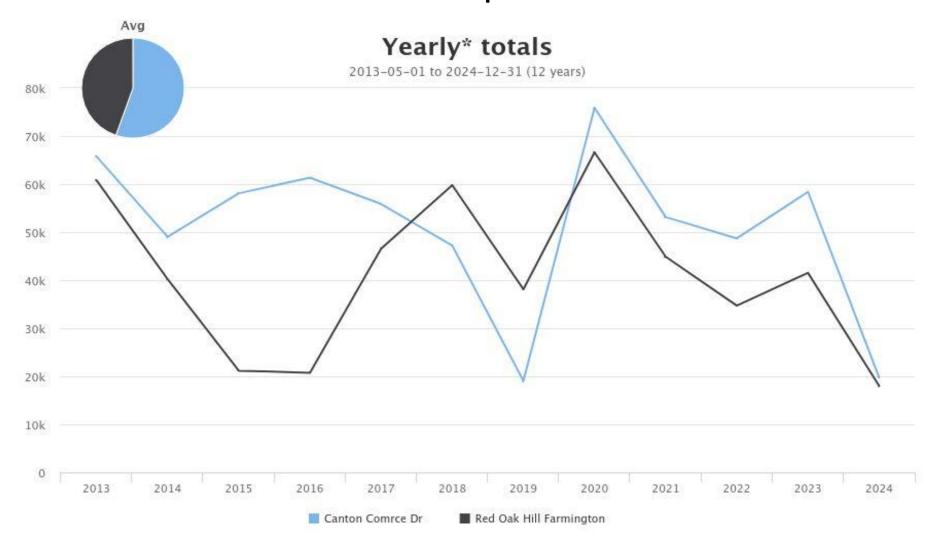


