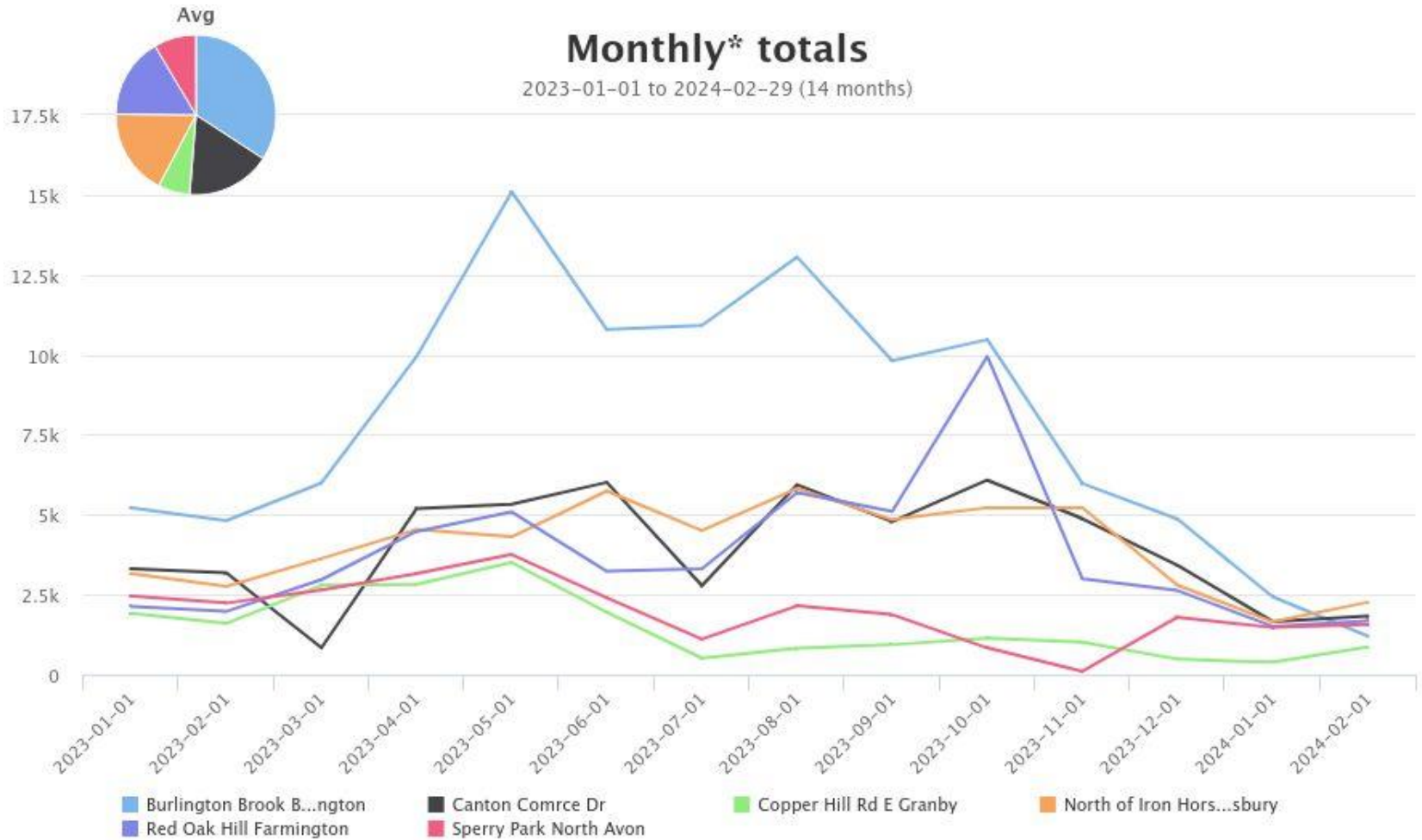

Graph of total usage 2023

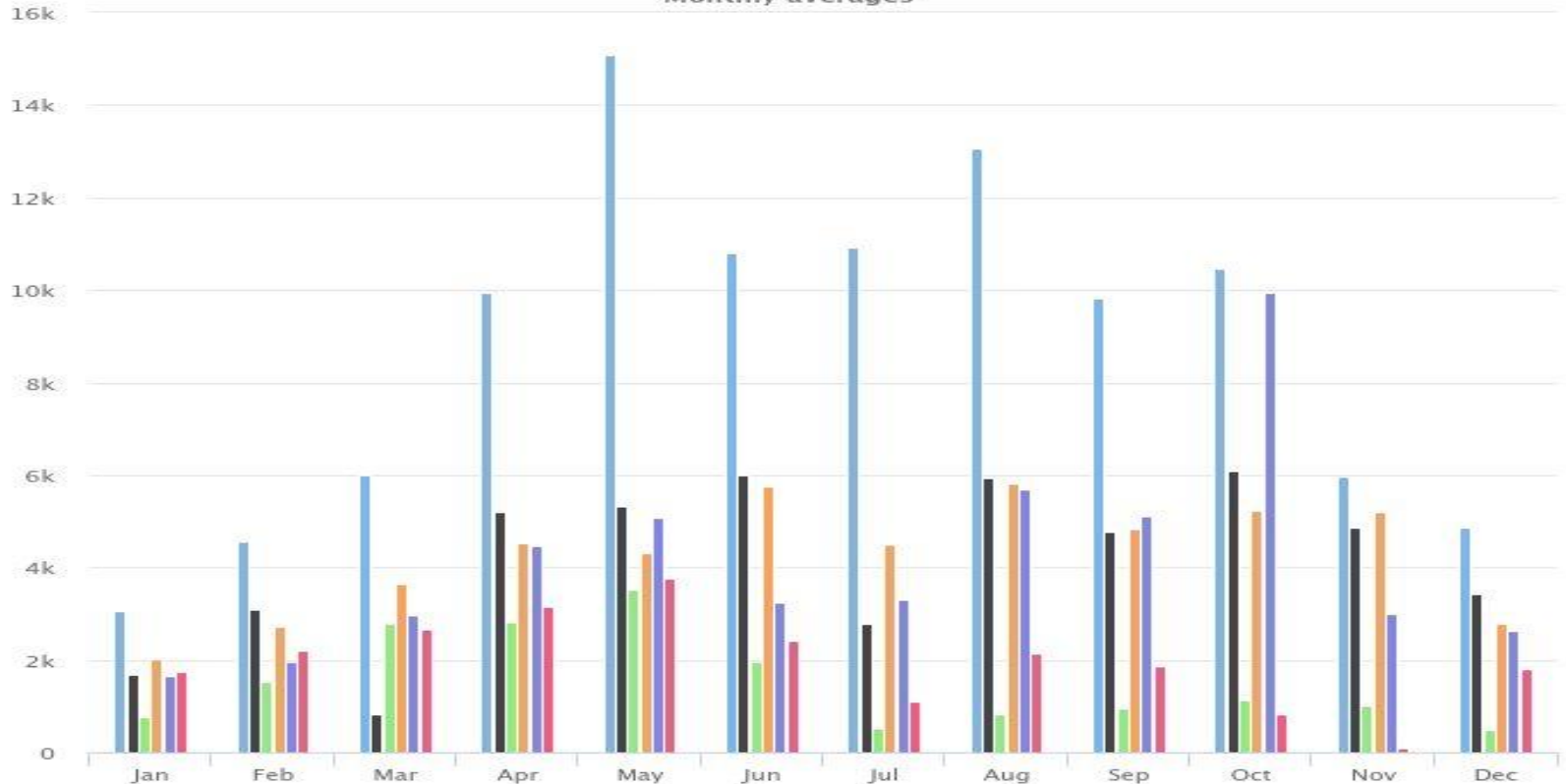


TRAFx Graph of Average usage by month and counter location 2022

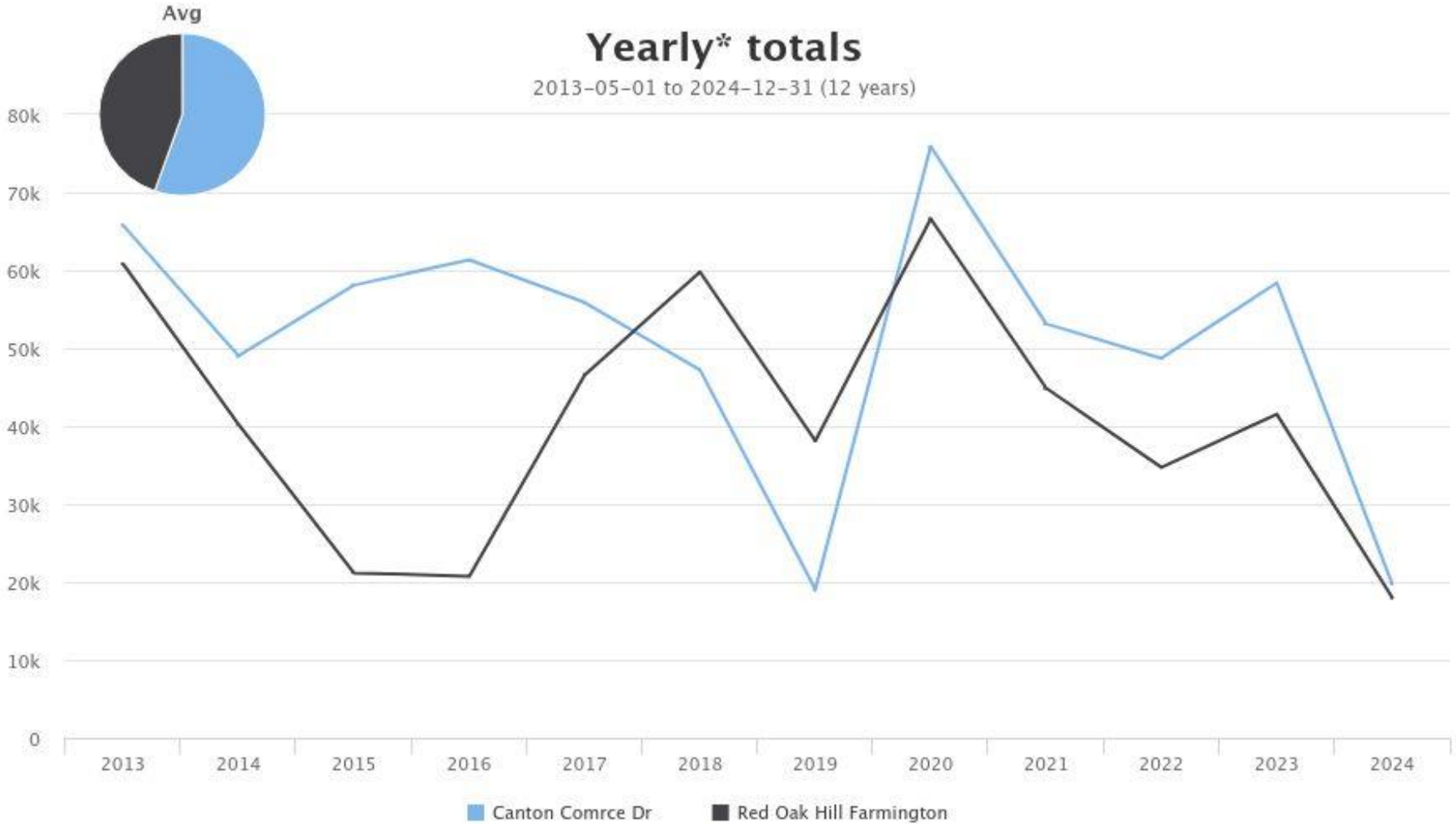

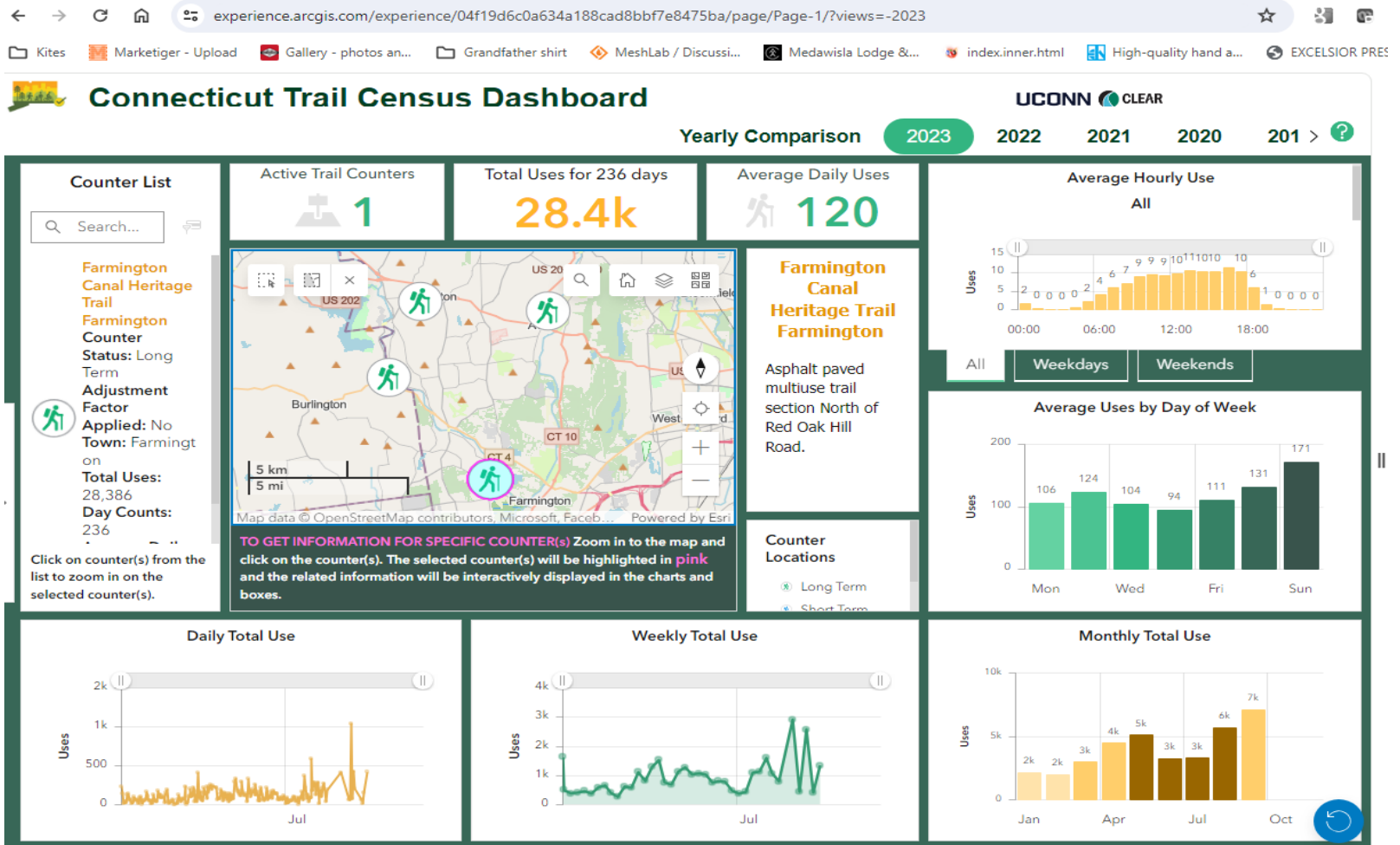
